

IBPS Specialist officer:-

Eligibility Criteria for IBPS SO Exam:-

- Moreover he/she must be an Indian citizen of above 21 years of age.

Once the exam is over the score card is provided to the candidates who have qualified for the next round for **interview**. Presently there are total 19 bank shares who are affiliated with the IBPS system. After giving the interview these students can apply in different banks by showing their score cards. A score card is valid for only one year. If a candidate doesn't get any job in any bank then he /she have to sit for the IBPS SO exam again in the next year.

- Proper coaching of the teachers improves the **knowledge** and concept of the subjects


Quantitative Aptitude

This section is for testing the ability of solving **mathematical** questions. The topics of the mathematical questions are of class VII to class X. But the quality and standard of the questions

are high. Most of the IT officer aspirants find this section to be difficult. His sections comprises of 50 questions which carries 50 marks.

Verbal and Non verbal Reasoning

This section is for testing the mental ability of the candidates. How a candidate thinks and prepares himself swiftly for solving any problem. This is one of the easy sections and candidates must try to focus in this section. It consists of 50 questions of 1 mark each.
